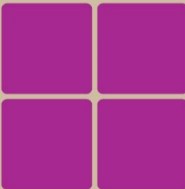
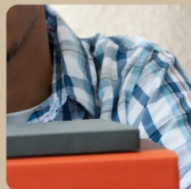


Have you been diagnosed with depression and have not responded to prior treatment with at least two antidepressants?

Do you continue to have depression symptoms despite taking antidepressant medications?

We are currently enrolling participants in a clinical research study to look at the effectiveness and safety of an investigational medication (given as a nasal spray) in patients with depression who have not responded to prior treatment with at least two antidepressants.



To be considered for the study, you must be 18 to 64 years old, diagnosed with depression and still be experiencing depression symptoms despite having taken two antidepressant medications in the past. You must be comfortable with using a nasal spray and able to provide written consent to participate.

The study doctor will discuss additional requirements for being in the study.

If you are eligible for this study and choose to participate, all study visits and study-related medical care will be provided at no cost to you. Compensation for your time and travel expenses may also be provided.
