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## Laboratory Services for Research:

KHSC Clinical Laboratory Services can provide clinical laboratory support for clinical trials and other research projects. The Lab has access to sophisticated instruments and analyzers, up to date methodologies and techniques, and is a fully accredited safe laboratory environment. Researchers should have confidence that the data obtained is reliable and valid. The Lab's highly specialized technical and professional staff take every effort to ensure that research protocols are stringently followed to support all of the researchers' needs. Prior to any services being provided for your clinical trial/research project, all certifications (i.e. human ethics, animal care, biohazards) and hospital approvals must be in place using the Queen's University Research Services' TRAQ DSS FORM.

### STUDY REQUEST FORM AND TRAQ DSS FORM

Researchers need to submit a "*KHSC Laboratory Services Study Request Form*". The completed form must be **ATTACHED** to your TRAQ DSS FORM prior to submission to ensure that your clinical trial/research project is processed in a timely manner and to minimize any delays in initiating your clinical trial/research project once all approvals have been obtained. Please remember to check off "*KHSC-Laboratories*" on the Approvals Tab of your TRAQ DSS FORM so that KHSC Clinical Laboratory Services can sign off on your TRAQ DSS FORM.
