Reportable Symptoms

1. Acute Respiratory Illness (ARI) – at least 3 of:

- Fever
- Cough
- Headache or eye pain
- Myalgia
- Malaise
- Sore throat

2. Gastroenteritis – at least 2 of:

- Vomiting
- Nausea
- Diarrhea
- Chills or shakes
- Abdominal pain

3. Conjunctivitis or "pink eye"

- Redness of the eye
- Discharge around the eye
