The Children's Outpatient Centre (COPC) at HDH provides a unique walk-in emergency clinic as well as specialized clinics for pediatric patients.

The Pediatric Program team includes nurses, physicians, patient care assistants, dietitians, speech language pathologists, respiratory therapists, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, pharmacists, Child Life specialists, social workers, spiritual care providers, volunteers and support staff.
