Creating a Shortcut to access your KHSC Volgistics Profile on an Android Device

Step 1: Open a web browser. With an Android device, you can use any web browser to place a shortcut on your home screen.



The screenshots in this section show how to do this with the Chrome browser on an Android tablet. The process will be similar with other browsers and devices.









Step 2: Open the HDH or KGH website

Open the HDH website <u>www.hoteldieu.com</u> click on Careers
& Volunteers and then the *Volgistics Profile & Schedule* link

OR

 Open the KGH website <u>www.kgh.on.ca</u> click on Working & Volunteering and then Our Volunteers and then the Resources for Current Volunteers link on the right









Step 3: Open the Log-in page

In the first paragraph, click where it says "...click here"

Accessing your profile and updating your schedule




Step 4: Add to Home Screen

When the screen to enter your Login Name (email address) and password is displayed, tap the web browser's menu and select *Add to Home screen*. (or you might see Add shortcut on Home Screen.)
