TRANSPORTATION PERKS

PARKING & BUS:

While paid parking options are available through Volunteer Services, parking at both hospitals is expensive and often at capacity. We encourage volunteers to carpool, have someone drop you off, walk, cycle or take a bus whenever possible. Please visit the City of Kingston's website to learn more about bus schedules as well as the "Park & Ride" and "Rack & Roll" options.

At the HDH Site:

Volunteers are reimbursed every 3-4 months for parking, bus or Access Bus expenses incurred to volunteer at Hotel Dieu Hospital. The reimbursement form is available from the volunteers at the Information Desk in the main lobby. It is also emailed out to all HDH site volunteers in advance of each submission time.

At the KGH Site:

Bus tickets are available for volunteers who ride the Kingston Transit or Access Bus to KGH. Paid parking is available in the Queen's University underground parking lot on Stuart Street during the hours you are volunteering at the hospital. Arrangements must be made with the Department of Volunteer Services.

BIKE RACKS are available for use at the main entrances of the hospitals. A secure bike lock-up area is also available upon request at the KGH site.

DISCOUNTS

Kingston Health Sciences Centre participates in the discount program offered through <u>VENNGO</u>, giving staff and volunteer's access to unique savings and discount programs from brand name companies and smaller local companies. Venngo provides real discounts from a growing list of over 1,500 brand name stores and local shops — accessible through mobile apps and online. You can save money on everything from wellness to entertainment. Once you begin volunteering you can set up an <u>account with Venngo</u> if you choose to do so.

VIA RAIL DISCOUNT:

STUDENT VOLUNTEER BURSARY


