## Dissolution of Hotel Dieu Hospital Kingston Research Institute

Effective June 1, 2019, HDHKRI transferred its assets, rights and obligations to KGHRI. Researchers involved in contracts with the HDHKRI may already have received a notification regarding the asset transfer and clarifying that there will be no impact on the conduct of their research.

## TRAQ DSS updates

#### **HOD Consolidation**

To avoid redundancy and improve the efficiency of the HOD approval process, some areas at both the HDH and KGH sites have been consolidated into KHSC areas. Effective October 1, 2019, you may notice that if you require TRAQ DSS approval by Pharmacy, Labs/Outpatient Diagnostic Labs, IT, Outpatient Cardiac Clinics, HMRC/L, or Research at either or both sites, there will by only one selection for KHSC, e.g. KHSC-Pharmacy.

Also effective October 1, 2019, Shari Glustein will sign off for KHSC-Research.

#### **New Amendment Form**

A new form entitled **Change in Study Team Request Form** has been created. This form is to be used to request changes to the study team members ONLY. If study team members will be performing significant study-related duties, have access to study data, or require access to the files/correspondence in TRAQ, they must be listed as a Project team member within the study files.
