KHSC reduces capacity at Detoxification Centre

Kingston, ON – April 1, 2020 – Kingston Health Sciences Centre (KHSC) has reduced the number of beds available at its Detoxification Centre in response to COVID-19, the novel coronavirus.

In order to accommodate the required social distancing needed during the pandemic, the bed availability at the Detox Centre has been reduced by 50 per cent, from 22 beds to 11.

People seeking the services of the centre should call before going to the facility to ensure availability and to be screened over the phone for COVID-19. The number to call is 613-549-6461. The same number can be used to access the Detox Centre's 24/7 phone support.

For those directed to come to the centre, a second COVID-19 screening process will happen upon entry.

All drop-in meetings organized by community groups, and normally held at the Detox Centre, have been suspended until further notice. The following are several online resources available:
