

This training can assist with fall outbreak preparedness and reinforce good IPAC practices.



COVID-19 Vaccine Education & Policies

When long term care homes were mandated to have a COVID-19 vaccine education program in place July 1st, the IPAC Hub recognized staff, volunteers and students work in multiple settings and organizations within the SE region. Our IPAC Hub team took this as an opportunity to continue to support our partners and provide a standardized regional education program. The material was reviewed by local public health units, experts and selected congregate settings.

It is offered in various formats including a Learning Module System (LMS) and a virtual presentation, if requested. The material and data was updated in response to Directive #6 and has since been used by many businesses and organizations both inside and outside of healthcare within the SE Region and throughout Ontario.

Rapid Antigen Testing

Our IPAC Hub team was kept busy early in September supporting Kingston Health Sciences Centre with preparing rapid antigen testing kits in follow up to Directive #6 for hospitals.

The team worked to validate testing kits prior to assembling the kits for distribution to staff. The team also provided on-site support to distribute the kits during the designated pick up times and helped to answer questions from staff about the new rapid testing requirements, process and questions related to COVID-19 vaccination.
