Since it started in 2005, the annual KGH Auxiliary Teddy Bear Campaign has raised just over \$400,000 to help purchase specialized pediatric equipment for the youngest patients at Kingston Health Sciences Centre.

Funds from our 18th annual campaign will purchase a MediTherm Hyper/Hypothermia System, technology connected to a special blanket and used to control body temperature. It will benefit a range of young patients including babies who are unable to stay warm in normal temperature ranges, patients who have trouble controlling their own body temperature and those need to be carefully warmed due to hypothermia.

By sponsoring a bear for \$100 you give the gift of much-needed pediatric medical equipment and deliver a clear message of caring and hope to children in hospital when the sponsored teddy bears are distributed at the end of the campaign.

Again this year, we cannot distribute tiny companion bears to sponsors but instead share them with our smallest patients and their families. As well, we will not be displaying sponsored bears in the KGH Watkins Lobby. These measures help to ensure minimum handling of the bears before they are delivered to sick children.
