Answer Questions 1-5 Below:		Instructions if "YES"
 I have a FEVER (temperature of ≥ 37.8 degrees Celsius) or any of the following SYMPTOMS (not related to other known conditions or COVID-19 vaccination in the past 48 hours) AND I have NOT been cleared by OHS to be in the workplace 	If Yes →	DO NOT ENTER THE WORKPLACE Notify your Manager and the Absence Reporting line x7425 if this is the usual protocol for you. Self-Isolate and notify Occupational Health, Safety & Wellness (OHSW) – KGH site x4389 (open 0700-1600); HDH site x2265 (open 0800-1600).
 Chills Cough Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing 		You should not present to screening with such symptoms, but if yo do, you will be instructed to call OHSW. Whether you are calling present to the OHSW department opening, or during their hours of operation please leave a message and your call will be returned as soon as possible. OHSW will assess your symptoms over the phone and in most case you will be required to have a COVID-19 PCR test. Rapid tests must not be used to clear yourself for work if you have symptoms. A PCR test is required
 Decrease or loss of sense of taste or smell 		
 Runny or stuffy/congested nose Muscle aches/joint pain Extreme fatigue/tiredness Sore throat Gastrointestinal symptoms (nausea/vomiting/diarrhea) 		If you've been tested for COVID-19 <u>due to symptoms</u> and are awaiting your results, you must self-quarantine until your results are received, regardless of whether you are vaccinated or not. If your swab result is negative (lab confirmed), you must contact OHSW to discuss return to the workplace; generally speaking, you will be able to return to work once your symptoms have improved for 24 hours provided you have no known exposure to a positive COVID-19 case. You may need a second PCR swab if your symptoms are not improving. If you are <i>now</i> asymptomatic (symptom free), but have not yet received your swab result, you must remain off work until the result is reported.

In the last 10 days I have had a positive lab confirmed (PCR) COVID-19 test, OR positive rapid antigen test AND I've not been cleared to return to work by OHS	If Yes→	DO NOT ENTER THE WORKPLACE and SELF-QUARANTINE Notify your Manager, and phone the Absence Reporting line x7425 if this is the usual protocol for you. Contact OHSW. KGH site x4389 (open 0700-1600); HDH site x2265 (open 0800-1600). Those who have had a positive test must promptly contact OHSW
If NO, please proceed to Question 4 below			DO NOT ENTER THE WORKPLACE Notify your Manager, and phone the Absence Reporting line x7425

Self-quarantine for the required period and monitor for symptoms. Should you develop any new symptoms of acute illness while off work on quarantine promptly report to OHSW and be PCR tested;

If any of the following apply to you, please SCAN STOP; you may work but are required to be on Work Isolation;	If Yes →	YOU CAN BE IN THE WORKPLACE BUT MUST BE ON WORK ISOLATION Stay on work isolation for 10 days after your last exposure to the COVID-19 risk or confirmed positive case; (unless OHSW has informed you otherwise or guidance below is different)

b)	I have a household contact who is experiencing new COVID-19 symptoms who has not yet had a COVID-19 test		Obtain the Work Isolation document at screening which gives you instructions for work isolation.
