Did you know?

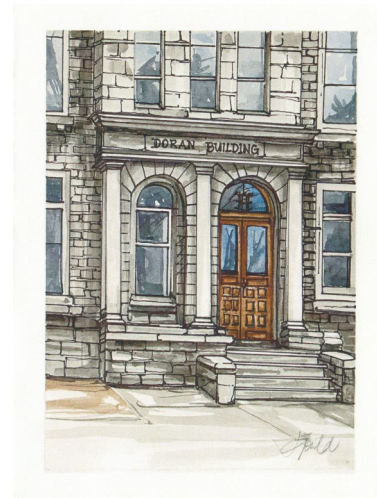
The KGHA contributes money annually to support redevelopment, education, equipment purchases, and KGH patient programs.

As a volunteer in the hospital, am I also an Auxiliary member?

No, a volunteer is not automatically an Auxiliary member. However, the Auxiliary is an organization that welcomes everyone! All you have to do is complete the application form on the back of this brochure and return it to us.

What is in it for me?

You become part of a group that raises and donates millions of dollars for patient care and hospital equipment.

You will receive regular Newsletters that inform you of our activities and enable you to spread the word about us to those you meet in the community.

Will I have the opportunity to take on a leadership role?
