

# COVID-19 Screening for KHSC Staff

Review the screening questions below. **By entering the workplace staff are attesting to answering “NO” to all screening questions. If “NO” to all, perform hand hygiene, don a mask, and report to work.**

**If you answer YES to any of questions 1, 2 or 3 below, DO NOT ENTER. Contact Occupational Health, Safety & Wellness (OHSW).**

Screening Question	Additional Guidance
<p><b>1. Do you have a FEVER (temperature of <math>\geq 37.8^{\circ}\text{C}</math>) OR any of the following SYMPTOMS (not related to other known conditions or COVID-19 vaccination in the past 48 hours):</b></p> <p>Runny or stuffy/congested nose, sore throat, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, decrease or loss of sense of taste or smell, muscle aches/joint pain, extreme fatigue/tiredness, gastrointestinal symptoms (nausea/vomiting/diarrhea)</p>	<p>Answer “NO” if your <u>COVID-19 PCR test</u> is negative and your acute symptoms have resolved.</p> <p>Answer “NO” if you’ve <u>been cleared by OHSW</u> to be in the workplace</p> <p><i>Note: If you have had COVID-19 in the past 60 days, a negative rapid antigen test is required instead of a PCR test.</i></p>
<p><b>2. Has one of your household contacts tested positive for COVID-19 in the <u>past 10 days</u>?</b></p>	<p>Answer “NO” if you’ve been cleared to be at work by your Manager or OHSW <b>AND</b> are following workplace isolation and testing requirements.</p>
<p><b>3. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 (rapid test or PCR test) <u>in the past 10 days</u></b></p>	<p>Answer “NO” if you’ve been cleared to return to work by OHSW <b>AND</b> are following workplace isolation requirements.</p>

## Conditions that require Staff to be on WORK ISOLATION:

- You have a **household member who has tested positive** for COVID-19 but you are symptom free, isolating from this contact, your initial COVID-19 PCR test is negative, **AND you have been cleared to return to work by your Manager or OHSW**
- You have a **household contact who is experiencing new COVID-19- like symptoms** who has not yet had a COVID-19 PCR test (you need to rapid test yourself daily until your household contact has their PCR test result)
- You have had a **high risk (non-household) contact to a COVID-19 positive** individual but you are symptom free, isolating from this contact, and will have a COVID-19 PCR test on Day 5 post exposure
- You have had COVID-19** and are returning to work prior to having completed your 10 day isolation period **AND** you’ve been cleared by OHSW to return to work.
