COVID-19 Screening for KHSC Staff

Review the screening questions below. By entering the workplace staff are attesting to answering "NO" to all screening questions. If "NO" to all, perform hand hygiene, don a mask, and report to work.

If you answer YES to any of questions 1, 2 or 3 below, DO NOT ENTER. Contact Occupational Health, Safety & Wellness (OHSW).

Screening Question	Additional Guidance
 1. Do you have a FEVER (temperature of ≥ 37.8°C) OR any of the following SYMPTOMS (not related to other known conditions or COVID-19 vaccination in the past 48 hours): Runny or stuffy/congested nose, sore throat, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, decrease or loss of sense of taste or smell, muscle aches/joint pain, extreme fatigue/tiredness, gastrointestinal symptoms (nausea/vomiting/diarrhea) 	Answer "NO" if your <u>COVID-19 PCR test</u> is negative and your acute symptoms have resolved. Answer "NO" if you've b <u>een cleared by OHSW</u> to be in the workplace <u>Note</u> : If you have had COVID-19 in the past 60 days, a negative rapid antigen test is required instead of a PCR test.
2. Has one of your household contacts tested positive for COVID-19 in the <u>past</u> <u>10 days?</u>	Answer "NO" if you've been cleared to be at work by your Manager or OHSW AND are following workplace isolation and testing requirements.
3. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 (rapid test or PCR test) <u>in the past 10</u> <u>days</u>	Answer "NO" if you've been cleared to return to work by OHSW AND are following workplace isolation requirements.

Conditions that require Staff to be on WORK ISOLATION:

- You have a household member who has tested positive for COVID-19 but you are symptom free, isolating from this contact, your initial COVID-19 PCR test is negative, AND you have been cleared to return to work by your Manager or OHSW
- You have a **household contact who is experiencing new COVID-19- like symptoms** who has not yet had a COVID-19 PCR test (you need to rapid test yourself daily until your household contact has their PCR test result)
- You have had a high risk (non-household) contact to a COVID-19 positive individual but you are symptom free, isolating from this contact, and will have a COVID-19 PCR test on Day 5 post exposure
- You have had COVID-19 and are returning to work prior to having completed your 10 day isolation period AND you've been cleared by OHSW to return to work.
