The KGH Pediatric Unit provides medical, surgical, oncology and intensive care services for infants, children, and youth from across Southeastern Ontario as well as those from the James Bay district. KGH's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit is one of six provincial perinatal centres caring for premature to full-term babies with a variety of complications. The Children's Outpatient Centre at HDH provides a unique walk-in emergency clinic as well as specialized clinics for pediatric patients.

The Pediatric Program team includes nurses, physicians, patient care assistants, dietitians, speech language pathologists, respiratory therapists, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, pharmacists, Child Life specialists, social workers, spiritual care providers, volunteers, and support staff.
