Achieving certification from the Certification Board of Infection Control and Epidemiology (CBIC) supports and demonstrates competency and commitment to the profession. Aligned with the *Fixing Long-Term Care Act*, the IPAC Standard Section 2 states IPAC Leads in LTC shall be certified by **April 2025**. Get certificated by challenging the CIC or LTC-CIP; either satisfies the IPAC Standard. If you choose to challenge your exam prior to the above date, the Hub can support your goal!


