Effective Study Techniques

- Create a study binder! (Focus on exam sections)
- Use **cue cards** (physical or online) *Quizlet is a free website for cue card creation!*
- Active recall test yourself on material rather than re-reading notes!
- **Pomodoro Technique** study for 25 minutes then take a 5-minute break to maintain focus
- Mind-Mapping visualize connections between concepts to better understand/organize information
- Colour-Coding use colours to organize information in your notes
