

KINGSTON GENERAL HOSPITAL A HISTORY OF OUR BABIES

Kingston General Hospital has been delivering and caring for newborns since 1854. The first official Maternity ward at KGH was opened in 1894 in the Doran wing. It moved in 1916 to the Nickle wing and then again in 1960, to the Connell wing. In 1989, the present Maternity ward on Kidd/Davies 5 was opened. In 1965, the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (one of six such units from across Ontario) was opened, serving Southeastern Ontario. Approximately 2,000 babies are born at KGH annually. The Kingston General Hospital is an internationally recognized teaching hospital affiliated with Queen's University.

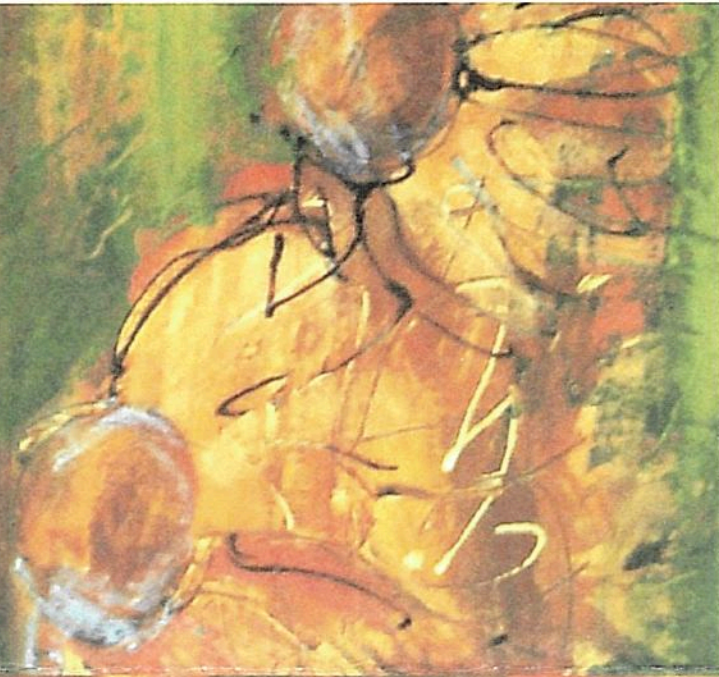
Plaques commemorating any past births at KGH may also be purchased.
