How to join a Clinical eVisit on a mobile device

Before your appointment, login to the application and go to the section **My Appointments**





Enter your appointment by clicking the **begin** button

How to join a Clinical eVisit using the Web App



To join the appointment go to the **My Appointments** section and click on the **begin** button

You will then be asked to check your webcam, microphone, and speakers

Click **Apply** after your AV check is completed

Click on **Enter virtual waiting room** to start or join the appointment

Reacts web app shared display feature

In order to use the shared display feature in the Reacts web app, you will need to have the Reacts Chrome Extension.

The Reacts Chrome extension only needs to be installed once, either on first login (recommended) or during a live Reacts session.

Follow the instructions on the screen to install.

Note that after installation of the extension during a session, the appointment will be interrupted, and you will need to call back your counterpart.

How to use the Share Screen feature in the web app

Click on the **Share Screen** button

Choose to either share your entire screen, or any of the applications running on your computer.





To stop sharing, either click on the Stop Sharing button in the menu bar at the bottom of the screen, or click the Stop Sharing button in the Reacts menu on the lower right side of the screen
