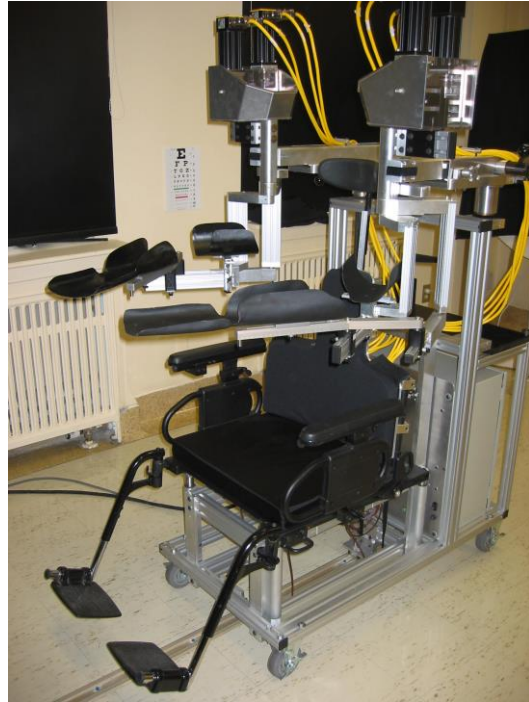
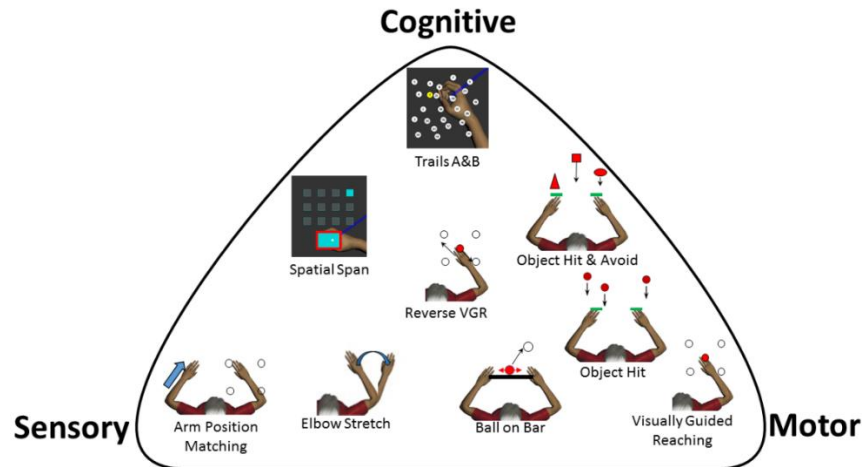


KINARM Multiple Sclerosis Study

The Laboratory of Integrative Motor Behaviour (LIMB) is inviting volunteers with MS to participate in a research study. This is a collaborative study with Dr. D. Brunet, Dr. A. Jin, Dr. S. Taylor and Dr. S. Scott



The study involves one of the robots above to complete a set of tasks, as shown at the top of this page. The robot on the left allows you to use handles to perform the tasks whereas the robot on the right supports your arms while performing the tasks. The robotic part takes about 40 minutes to complete. The other portion of the study consists of some questionnaires and a neurological assessment with a neurologist and some motor tasks. This portion of the study takes about 1-1½ hours to complete.

Participants will receive a small monetary compensation for their involvement.
